pio command

### DESCRIPTION

The given command is executed using physical I/O to/from all files where possible. If physical I/O is not possible, the system does the appropriate side-buffering.

This command is useful for doing "check", "dd" and other UNIX type commands which make use of raw I/O, e.g.

pio dd if=/dev/rp0 of=/dev/mt0 ibsize=8192 obsize=4096 count=512.
