DESCRIPTION

Shift is used in command files to shift the argument list left by 1, so that old \$2 can now be referred to by \$I\$ and so forth. Shift is useful to iterate over several arguments to a command file. For example, the command file

```
while test "$1" !=""
do
echo $1
shift
done
```

prints each of its arguments on a separate line.

Shift is executed within the Shell.
