INTRODUCTION TO SUBROUTINES

GENERAL

This section describes a small assortment of available subroutines. The binary form of most of them is kept in the system library /lib/liba.a. The subroutines available from C and from Fortran are also included; they reside in /lib/libc.a and /lib/libf.a respectively.

A new input/output subroutine package has been written by Dennis Ritchie: A New Input Output Package. It is a faster and cleaner set of routines with a broader scope of applicability than the current standard IO software. System software in UNIX and MERT is being converted to use these routines; conversion to future versions of the UNIX and MERT operating systems will be easier if this package is used. Hence, MERT users are urged to use this IO package whenever possible. Documentation has been added under NEWIO(III) in this section.
